NRI Admission 2017-Prospectus New

If you apply for both Management and NRI seats, you should pay Rs.1250/- as Demand Draft drawn in favour of Principal, co-operative College of Nursing as application fee.

Eligibility criteria for Admission to the Courses:

NRI quota

Indian citizens only are eligible for admission to nursing courses. Persons of Indian origin (PIO) and overseas citizens of India (OCI) will also be treated at par with Indian citizens for the limited purpose of admission.

Those who apply under NRI quota should satisfy all the conditions stipulated in GO (MS) NO.34/2013/H & FWD dated 05-02-2013 and GO (MS) No.193/2013/H&FWD dated 22-05-2013 and GO(MS) No.243/2014/H&FWD dated 06-08-2014 of the Govt. of Kerala regarding NRI status. NRI applicant is he/she who depends upon his/her father /mother/brothers and sisters(inclusive of first cousins) of father or mother/husband/wife/brother/half brother/half sister/Adopted father/Adopted mother working abroad. Selection will be made based on the merit. Merit will be decided on the basis of the marks obtained in the qualifying examinations and in a personal interview. Rank list will be prepared by taking 80% marks for the qualifying examination (Subjects-Physics and Chemistry) and 20% for the interview Applicants seeking admission under NRI quota should produce the following certificates/ documents apart from other certificates/documents required for management open quota applicants.

- 1) Copy of Passport and Visa attested by the respective Indian Embassy/ Consulate.
- 2) If the Visa is not stamped, employment certificate duly attested by the respective Indian Embassy/Consulate.
- 3) Sponsorship certificate.
- 4) Relationship Certificate from Village Officer.
- 5) NRI Bank Account Details
